Following the success of earlier events in the series, started in 2009 in Brighton, SEB 2016 took place in the lively city of Torino, Italy, hosted in Politecnico di Torino and organised in partnership with KES International.

SEB Series Conferences deal with a range of sustainability and energy related topics, including sustainable design of buildings, energy city models, smart energy systems for smart cities, green information communications technology, renewable energy systems and technologies, intelligent energy management and optimization.
