# **Full Labs and Motivated students:**

#### Interactive labs via low stakes assessment



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Weekly graded labs (low-stakes assessment) get students to engage, attend, and get to know each other. This approach is suitable for any module that has a CA.



## Mobile S/W Dev

Weekly labs are graded, worth 20% of the module grade;


**Simple to implement:** Labs are graded during the lab **no submissions**, and no after-lab corrections;

Very simple grading scheme for all lab assistants

**Feedback** is via tutorial walkthrough and solutions posted after;

Motivated students, wellpaced learning; active labs

The full picture of attendance and progress is a natural by-product!




### **Databases 1**

Nine Labs are graded, and 30% of the module grade

Task/quiz released at the start of the lab with submission and demo before the end.

Attending students' work is marked by a very simple, visible rubric

The rubric gives the students feedback.



## **Networking 2**

Weekly labs are graded, worth 20% of the module grade;

#### Self-correcting labs:

Submitted at the end of a 2-hour session.

**Feedback:** Via Moodle to each student based on their submission.

**Targeted support:** Based on the previous week's submission.

**Lab Attendance & Engagement:** Hugely improved

**Results:** Comparison to previous networking module shown
