Introduction

i.

After more than a century of French rule, Algeria achieved independence on July 3rd 1962. For the period of the French occupation and also for the post-colonial period the basic source material on Algeria remains in the French language. Nevertheless, the heroic efforts of the Algerian people in their struggle for independence aroused the interest of the English speaking world, in particular Britain, U.S.A. and Canada - an interest which has continued to grow since independence as a result of closer economic and political links. Consequently, from the beginning of the war of independence in 1954, a considerable number of books and articles on Algeria in the English language have appeared.

The present work represents a first attempt to compile a bibliography of source material on Algeria published in the English language since 1954. It is hoped that this bibliography will be of use not only to students and research workers, but also to other persons interested in Algeria.

The bibliography includes both periodical articles and books, and is organized into six parts according to subject. Within each part, books and articles are listed separately and arranged by author in alphabetical sequence. No bibliography is ever complete, and I apologise if, inadvertently, certain sources which should have been included have been omitted.
