The second issue of ANZJES for 2022 is the outcome of the joint conference of the Australasian Association for Communist and Post-Communist Studies (AACaPS) and European Studies Association of Australia and New Zealand (ESAANZ), hosted by the RMIT University's European Union Centre of Excellence in November 2021.

The conference was held in a hybrid mode at the time Australia and other parts of the world were coming out of the lockdowns and restrictions related to the Covid-19 pandemic. Over the past two years, we became acutely aware of the Covid-19 related borders and boundaries. This ANZJES issue represents a sophisticated mix of papers from scholars with European and Eurasian perspectives on issues related to pandemic, nationalism, devolution, sovereignty, governance, and economic performance in the EU and/or Central Asia and China. It is another important contribution to the European and Eurasian Post-Communist scholarship in Australia
