

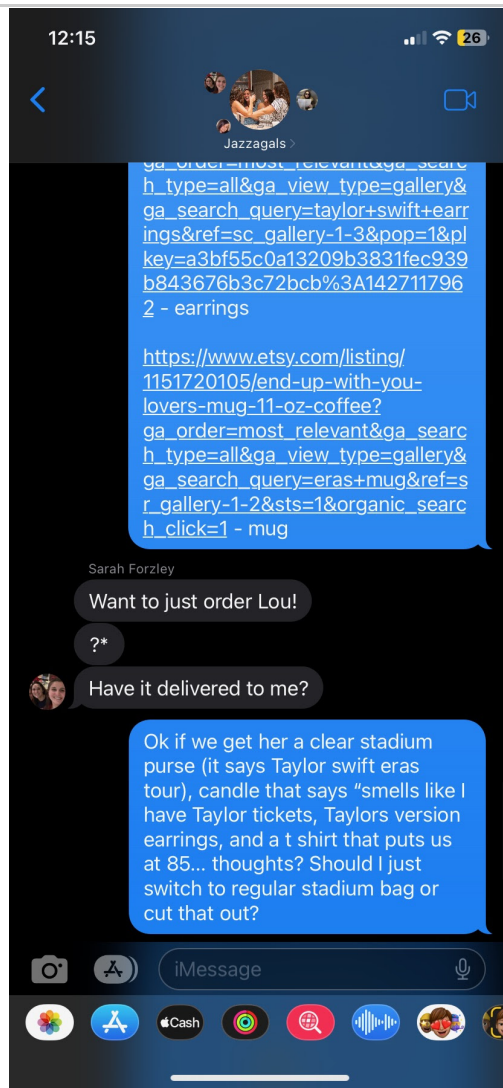

JACKIE'S CORNER:

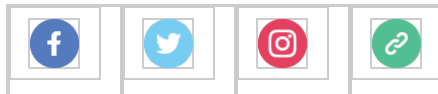
