REMARKS OF SENATOR EDMUND S. MUSKIE AT THE BANGOR AREA COPE DINNER OCTOBER 3, 1970

I AM HAPPY TO BE HERE:

--TO TELL YOU TEAT I VALUE THE ENDROSEMENT YOU HAVE GIVEN US IN THIS CRUCIAL ELECTION YEAR:

THROUGH NOVEMBER 3.

BACK IN THE DAYS OF THE STAGECOACH, THERE WAS
A STORY ABOUT A COACHMAN WHO HAD A HABIT OF FLICKING HIS
WHIP AS HE DROVE ALONG THE ROAD-SPLITTING A HORSEFLY IN
TWO...OR SLAPPING A BUMBLEBEE TO THE GROUND.

ONE DAY, A PASSENGER HAPPENED TO ASK WHY HE
REFUSED TO USE HIS WHIP ON A NEST OF HORNETS THAT WAS

MUST PAY MORE THEN 10 PERCENT TO FINANCE THEIR CONSTRUCTION—AND PURCHASERS MUST PUT UP ANOTHER 9 PERCENT OR MORE IN INTEREST CHARGES.

MILLION MORE AMERICANS WERE OUT OF WORK LAST MONTH THAN
