3 rd Sytember 1944 Deur Chris Have intended writing you before now but I had tomislaid (?) your address and since we can't take correspondence into Combat did not have it Serhaps ) im has written you that I caught a hip slug in my throat - any way I'm doing fine with the exception that I can't talk - Can only whige and the doctors tell he not to even do that. This wound is a clean hale through and through - Fook off my adam's apple leng lit is healing Hast - They are sending me home in a few weeks-That is I expect to be in California soon - This hospital is very nice and we get excellent food-The nurses are very nice too

and I'm actually enjoying the rest- my wound has hiver really been painful and with the exception, at first, of having a little trouble bleathing has not been very bothersome. Was leading a Company attach on pill botes when t it happened - We accomplished our mission of knocking im out though It (the bullet) didn't knock me out and I was able to write on a pad which, luckily, I had with me was evacuated pretty grich after that I consider thyself a mighty lucky fellow! Doctors (specialists here) tell me its going to take time and they are a list vaque as to when but I am confident that when I got hack to the mainland with plenty of rest and verlage.
