STATE OF MAINE, To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting! Knows ye, That We, confiding in the ability, discretion and integrity of J. S. Wheelmight of Sangor Osquise, by and with the advice and consent of the Council, have assigned, constituted and appointed, and by these Presents do assign, constitute and appoint him the said L. S. Wheelinight to be one of our Justices of the Veace and of the Quorum, within and for the County of Peurlasch Elden Convor for and during the term of Seven Jears from the date of these Presents, if he shall so long behave himself well in said office. And we do hereby authorize and enjoin him, the said L.S. Thelmight Equire, to keep and cause to be kept the Laws and Ordinances made for the good of the peace and the conservation of the same, and for the quiet rule and government of our citizens and persons subject to our jurisdiction in the said County; and to execute and perform all the powers and duties which by our Laws appertain to the said Office, so long as he shall hold the same by virtue of these Vresents. In testimony whereof we have caused our Seal to be hereunto affixed. Witness, SELDEN CONNOR, our Governor. Given at Augusta, this Sexteenth day of October in the year of our Gord one thousand eight hundred and seventy eight and in the one hundred and their year of the Independence of the United States of America.
