To all to whom these Presents shall come,  
Greeting.

Know Ye, That We, confiding in the ability, discretion  
and integrity of

J. S. Wheelwright  
of Bangor

Esquire, by and with the advice and consent of the  
Council, have assigned, constituted, and appointed,  
and by these Presents do assign, constitute and appoint  
him the said J. S. Wheelwright to be one of our  
Justices of the Peace and of the Quorum,  
within and for the County of Penobscot

Selden Connor for, and during the term of Seven Years from  
the date of these Presents, if he shall so long behave himself  
well in said office.

And we do hereby authorize and enjoin him, the said  
J. S. Wheelwright Esquire, to keep and cause to be kept  
the Laws and Ordinances made for the good of the peace and  
the conservation of the same, and for the quiet rule and govern-  
ment of our citizens and persons subject to our jurisdiction in the  
said County; and to execute and perform all the powers and  
duties which by our Laws appertain to the said Office, so long  
as he shall hold the same by virtue of these Presents.

In testimony whereof we have caused our Seal to be hereunto affixed.

Given at Augusta, this sixteenth day of October in  
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight  
and in the one hundred and thirtieth year of the Independence  
of the United States of America.
