




1980 graduates

A Silver Anniversary Event

Approximately 600 attend inaugural honors ceremony

Superior teaching is the primary focus of Parkland, President Zelema Harris told approximately 600 persons attending the First Honors Day Convocation in the Gymnasium on Thursday evening.

Seventy-seven percent of Parkland students are over the age of 21, women account for 59 percent of the student population, and women between the ages of 25 and 34 are the fastest growing student group, President Harris said.

Daniel Eaton, director, Parkland College Foundation, said, "As we gather together to honor our students, our colleagues, and special friends for their achievement, we honor ourselves as well."

Eaton added that he hopes "this Honors Day Convocation will become a tradition, one that will serve to bind us together in a richer sense of community."

Those who were honored were asked to stand; then their families were asked to stand to emphasize their contributions to their students' educations.

Madonna Kirk, president, Student Government, recognized those who had academic honors for Spring and Fall, 1991. Next honored were members of Alpha Omega Honorary Society (students who received above a 3.6 average) for summer and fall, 1991.

Linda Huth was recognized for having received the Intellectual Freedom Essay Contest award for Parkland College.

Christy Capie was honored as the receiver of the Delta Kappa Gamma 1992 Scholarship Award.

Text of Presidents' Honors Day speech

Harris praises staff, encourages students

Good Evening. Tonight will long be remembered as one of the most significant events to occur in the history of Parkland College, so, it is appropriate that our first Honors Day Convocation is taking place during the celebration of Parkland's 25th anniversary.

Tonight is a time to reflect and to thank those visionaries who saw the need for a community college; to honor those who have benefitted from that vision, and to recognize those colleagues, who through the years of dedication, have created one of the best community colleges in America.

It is an honor for me to participate in this commemorative event. It was only a few months ago that Dan Eaton, director of the Parkland College Foundation, approached me with the idea of a convocation. Dan immediately won support for the idea from the various college constituencies. The Parkland College Association, under the leadership of Rich Blazier, soon joined with the Parkland Foundation to co-sponsor Parkland's first Honors Day Convocation. Not only did Dan serve as the impetus for tonight's convocation, but he also gave my speech the long title that you see on the program.

I suppose though that all of these nouns than Dan selected as my topic: achievement, adversity, persistence, and growth, represent the opportunities at Parkland as well as the barriers that many of our students face.

The opportunities at Parkland grow out of our unique mission as a community college—a mission distinctly different from any other form of higher education in the world: to open doors to everyone who can benefit from college instruction. Community colleges democratized higher education in America by challenging the doctrines that you must have money or be able to prove that you are worthy of an education.

Community colleges are positioned to confront the greatest educational challenge—that of meeting the educational needs of a highly diverse student population. Our diversity is reflected by the number of older students

enrolled, the number of students who are the first generation to attend college, more female-headed households, more women on public aid, students who were not successful in high school, and more GED completers.

The average age of our student population is 29. Approximately 77 percent of our students are over the age of 21. Our fastest growing student group are women between the ages of 25 and 34. Women students represent approximately 59 percent of our student population. Finally, more minorities are perceiving Parkland as the school of choice.

Our diversity is also reflected in serving a growing percentage of high school graduates who could have attended four-year colleges and universities, but chose instead to attend an institution where teaching is our primary focus.

Currently there are 34 valedictorians and salutatorians enrolled at Parkland who are from the 28 high schools in our district. Seventeen percent of our student population is non-white. African-Americans represent the largest percentage of minorities with a record high this semester of 10.5 percent. Asians represent the second highest at 2.4 percent.

The opportunity to be taught by faculty who must consider the broad range of student abilities, motivation levels, cultural backgrounds, ages, and family commitments is recognized and appreciated by our students. I constantly hear this from parents, grandparents, and from the students themselves.

Since many of our students have had to overcome adversities in achieving their goals, I asked our faculty to share with me some of the students' experiences.

Chuck Newman, a full-time speech instructor at Parkland for 20 years asked that I use one of our own successful faculty members as an example of a Parkland success story. Chuck describes this success story: "About 16 years ago, an 18-year-old loud mouth came to Parkland. This 18-year-old thought he was Mohammed Ali,

was not focused, and lacked discipline." The student came from a single-parent home, got in trouble, and had a few brushes with the law.

He enrolled in Chuck Newman's class and was encouraged to participate on the debate team where he became a national champion. He graduated from Parkland in 1978 and received a scholarship to attend Bradley University, where he again became a national champion in speech and forensics. Upon graduation from Bradley in 1980, he received a scholarship to Eastern Michigan University where he earned a Master's degree in Speech Communications in 1982.

Today, this young energetic man teaches Speech Communications at Parkland College, and is assistant director of the speech forensics team.

This success story belongs to none other than Kent Redmon.

Kent credits his success, in large measure, to Dave Jones, former Speech instructor, and now chair of the department of Fine and Applied Arts, and to his office mate, Chuck Newman.

Another short and poignant success story come from Carol Edginton Castellon, a part-time instructor who has been teaching at Parkland since 1978: During the Spring semester of 1982, in Math 123, a young female student asked for a week of assignments in advance. She said she would be out of town but wanted to keep up with the classwork. When I asked the reason for being out of town, she told me she was getting into sport speedskating and was to compete at a meet.

This student's name was Bonnie Blair. Bonnie was a conscientious student. She earned an A in Math 123.

There are thousands of success stories like those I received from faculty.

The students who are being honored tonight represent both the opportunity than Parkland provides and their own efforts to overcome adversity.


