BIO FOR REV. BILL WATSON

Rev. Bill Watson came to Morehead First Christian Church on January 1, 1998. He had previously served as Senior Minister of Shawnee Christian Church in Louisville, Kentucky. Bill was born and raised in Western Kentucky and although he felt called to the ministry early in life, he worked a variety of jobs before entering Christian Theological Seminary in Indianapolis, Indiana, in 1979.

His ministries included a small country church and chaplaincy in a children's hospital, a state mental hospital and a general hospital. After graduating Cum Laude from Christian Theological Seminary, Bill served briefly as Chaplain in a home for older adults before being called to serve on the mission field in the Kingdom of Swaziland, Africa.

During his six years in Africa, he served as a Rural Development Officer for the Swaziland Council of Churches. His main job was finding water for communities in a very poor semi-arid portion of that country. He also assisted with community gardens, tree growing projects, sunflower production, refugees, writing international grants, and developed the relationship between the KukhayO'Kusha Zion Church and the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ).

For nine months after returning from Africa, Rev. Watson served as a Resident Chaplain to Children's Hospital Medical Center in Cincinnati, Ohio. This hospital is the largest pediatrics hospital in the United States and serves as the trauma hospital for a tri-state area.

Bill Watson brings a wide variety of experiences and background for ministry to First Christian Church - Morehead. He is a nationally known storyteller and performed at the Corn Island Storytelling Festival in 1997. His energy and faith is contagious and no one is a stranger.
