This paper contrasts the asylum policies in the Trump Administration to those of the Obama Administration.


METHODOLOGY

- Enforcement across these administrations







FINDINGS

1. Although rhetoric can alter public opinion, it has often been unrelated to the development of asylum policies and enforcement.

- 2. Harsh detention practices that are often associated with
- the Trump Administration through public opinion and the
- media, were developed during the Obama Presidency and
 - continually perpetuated in President Trump's term.
- **3. President Trump signed harsh executive actions against**
 - the asylum system, compared to President Obama.


ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Major Policy Initiatives During The Trump Administration: -Migrant Protection Protocols (Remain in Mexico) -"The Muslim Ban" -Family Separation -Border wall construction

Major Policy Initiatives During the Obama Administration -Obama's Response to the 2014 influx of Central American Arrivals -Defered Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) -Family separation and detention

ICE arrests went up after Trump took office, but remain lower than during much of Obama's tenure
