ABOUT THE MARIACHI PROGRAM DIRECTOR



Dr. Tammy Yi is an assistant professor of music education at Chapman University and Conductor of the Los Angeles Philharmonic Youth Orchestra of LA. As a scholar, she presents her work on racial and social justice in orchestral pedagogy at music education conferences around the world including NAFME, ASTA, CASMEC, CMEA, and ISME. Dr. Yi also serves on the national board for the American String Teachers Association, and has several publications in the American String Teacher Journal, Music Educators Journal, and many more. As a conductor, she has led orchestras in venues such as the Sydney Opera House, Carnegie Hall, Walt Disney Concert Hall, Royal Festival Hall, Hollywood Bowl and the University of Oxford. At Chapman, she teaches courses with topics specializing in string education, democratic classrooms, ethnic studies, creativity, anti-racism, and social justice. She is founded the first collegiate mariachi ensemble in Orange County with her students, Mariachi Panteras. Dr. Yi has received high recognition and awards including the Winston Family Endowment, Pedagogical Innovation Award, Innovation in Diversity and Inclusion Research Award, Florence Geffen Award, Ella Fitzgerald Award, and a nomination from the Grammy Foundation. Yi continues to perform, conduct, and train musicians while challenging systems of oppression in the performing arts world.
