> Public condemnation and rejection of individuals, due to their historical actions, beliefs, or statements that are deemed offensive or unacceptable by current standards.



Many sculptures, viewed as offensive and outdated, have been vandalized or removed. However, some have criticized it as a form of erasure of history

Augmented Reality

permits to avoid physically altering or interfering with the original monuments, while providing an alternative point of view

enables creation of an immersive and interactive experience, which has the potential to engage contemporary audience "It has always been the prerogative of ruling elites to determine the nature, placement and aesthetic of public monuments"

Monument of Discoveries

constructed in 1940 to commemorate Infante D. Henrique, the most important figure in the beginning of the country's maritime expansion

By juxtaposing the

AR sculpture of Velho do Restelo

with the Monument of Discoveries, the project aims to challenge the dominant narrative and provide an alternative perspective on the historical events depicted.

Potential of

AR counter-sculptures

- 1. providing a space for expressing different perspectives or critical view of the events portrayed by the original sculpturest
- 2. offering a space for marginalized voices and alternative perspectives to be heard, challenging dominant narratives
- 3. promoting a more inclusive and accurate representation of history
- 4. offering an alternative to the physical interference with the existing monuments, thus helping to preserve cultural heritage
- 5. contributing to the remembrance, through revisiting and rereading old monuments in itself
- 6. creating engaging experience for younger audiences
