- o Original VADDS System launched in 2003.
- o Windows 2003/MS-SQL2005 system deployed in 2008 after catastrophic crash
- o Hosted by Research Computing Data Center since 2008.



***** Key Factors behind this Migration Project.

- o Both the server OS and DB are now off vendor support
- o Hardware is now off warranty and disks have shown evidence of failures to come.
- o Repeated disruptions at the RCC Data Center have prompted a desire to move the system to a more stable platform and/or location.

When Project Schedules Become Irrelevant.

- o Original project schedule called for July startup when funds became available.
- o Schedule halted due to impending move by the NHVDL to new facility under construction with mid August target date.
- o Construction delays pushed the move into early September after start of school year.

Server Migration Project 2.0 – The Reboot

- o November 2015: Notice from ATC that client software price is in the offing.
- o Must install before December 30th or face substantial price increase.
- o Result? Project back on track on high speed schedule.
- o New System handed over to NHVDL in February 2016.
