Convenient Moveable Effective Easy to Monitor Less Expensive than **Plumbing**




Can be as simple as you wish

Basic Hand Washing Station Parts List



Water from an Approved Source means

- Municipal Water Source
 OR
- ◆ Tested well water free of Escherichia coli (E. coli)
 OR

◆ Surface water that has been treated and free of E. coli



When to Wash Hands:

- After using the toilet
- Before starting/returning to work
- Before and after eating or smoking
- Before putting on gloves
- After working with animals
- Any time your hands may have become contaminated
