[Changemaker Fellowship](#) is a cohort of first-year and transfer students – 42 students strong this year (up from 10 in last year’s pilot)! This is a new signature program of the UNH Changemaker Collaborative, a partnership at UNH between the Sustainability Institute, the Paul College of Business & Economics and the Carsey School of Public Policy. The Changemaker Collaborative offers high-impact programs

and events for all students, no matter your major or your interests, to help you graduate with the courage, confidence and skills to create a world where people, planet and economies all thrive.

Fellows are matched with a peer mentor, engage in professional development and sustainability-related learning, attend monthly meetings and have opportunities to participate in experiential programs through the Changemaker Collaborative.

2020 is no stranger to unconventional beginnings and the Changemaker Fellowship is no exception. That being said, the Fall cohort has proved just how powerful collaboration and innovation can be, even in times of uncertainty.

The Fellows kicked off the semester with a socially distanced welcome. They enjoyed sunshine, a game of cornhole, and got to know their cohort, as well as their peer mentors, the [Changemaker Coaches](#). Although the Fellows had met over Zoom this summer, this was the first time they all were all able to see each other in person!

September brought professional development opportunities; Fellows had the chance to write bios and get headshots taken to use for LinkedIn and other professional endeavors. They were also introduced to the United Nations [Sustainable Development Goals](#) (SDGs), which are the primary focus during their monthly meetings, also known as “Happy Hours”, and they planned the SDG topics that they wished to explore throughout the semester. At each Happy Hour, the cohort investigates and presents on powerful innovations that are taking place around the world pertaining to each month’s spotlighted SDG.
