Monday through Thursday

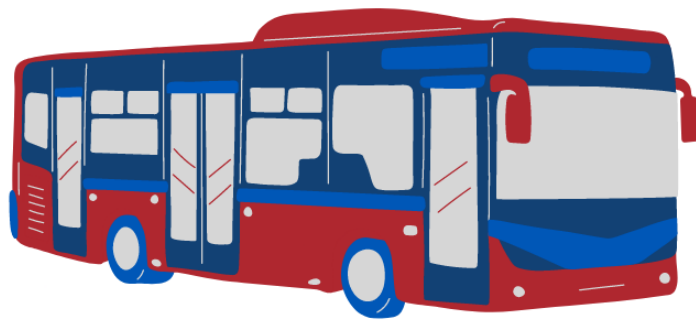
