


Figure 1 Gender Distribution of Participants




Figure 2: Age Distribution of Participants




Figure 3 Distribution of Participants' Education Status




Figure 4 Distribution of Participants' Income Status




Figure 5 Status of the Relationship Between Participants' Income Status and Divorce




Figure 6 Status of the Relationship Between Participants' Income Status and Number of Children
