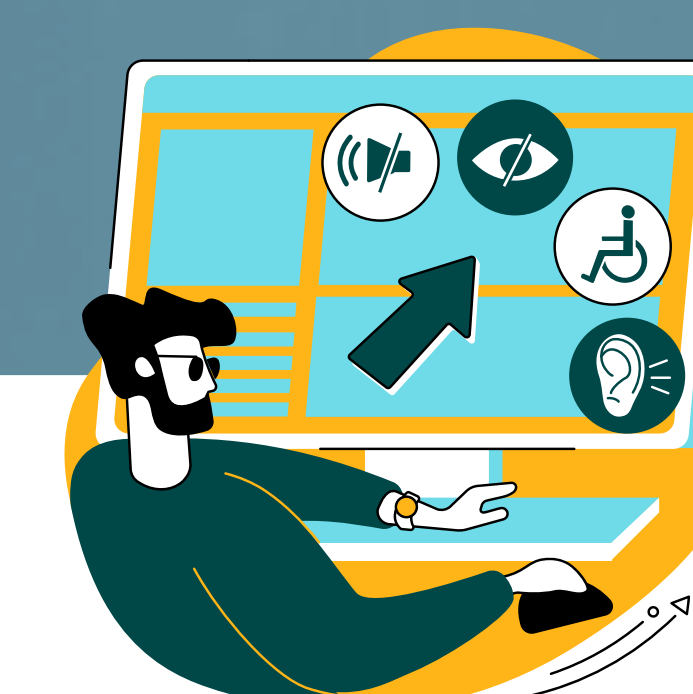
## Signposting users to trusted resources
