 - EOSC


- Align gaia-x principles with FAIR principles

 - Legal: Data privacy and intellectual property








Envisioned System Overview



Demonstrator "FAIR Data Scorecard"


- HTML Report
 - Human Readable
 - Text & Visuals
- JSON Report
 - Key/Value Pairs
 - Key: Data filepath
 - Value: Success/Warn/Error
- Other outputs can be accomplished based on needs of other demonstrators
 - curl to push files to specific locations?
 - ???








FAIR Data Scorecard - Results

But what if I want more than simple pages?



Beyond Simple Web Pages


Don't do it

- If you have to use high level infrastructures
 - cloud container service > virtual machine > hardware server

... yes, you will need to maintain your own server!



You need your own (web) server

Recommendataion I

- If you can: stick to GitLab Runner + Pages
- It is far more complex than GitLab Pages!
- It is some additional work but you might gain reproducibility



Recommendataion I

- For a simple setup this technology stack worked well
 - Any Linux OS
 - Docker (+ Docker Compose)
 - GitLab Runner for automation
 - Traefik as HTTP reverse proxy
- If you have many pages like this consider using GitLab Environments
