Saint of the Week: St. James the Greater **with Morgan Gafford**




St. James the Greater was one of the Twelve Apostles and Jesus's cousin. He and his brother, John, were devout followers of Jesus—but also known for having fiery tempers and bold personalities. After evangelizing in Spain for almost forty years, James returned to Jerusalem and was beheaded by order of King Herod; he was the first apostle to sacrifice his life. The cross of St. James resembles a sword, signifying his martyrdom.

Legend holds his remains were miraculously returned to Compostela, Spain—the destination of the Camino de Santiago pilgrimage. Various routes throughout Portugal, Spain, and France converge on the shrine, like lines on a scallop shell. Thus, shells are worn on the journey to identify as peregrinos (pilgrims). 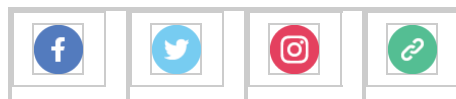
