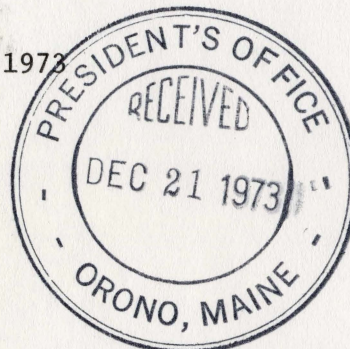

Dear Dr. Nevell,

On behalf of thousands of good taxpayers and church people of the State of Maine I wish to register our disapproval of the official sanction of the practice of homosexuals and their organized groups on the U of M campuses.

Our attention has been called to the official sanction of "gay blades" through the Oscar Wilde Club, the organized homosexual group on your campus. I refer in particular to the Associated Press announcement of the dance held for homosexuals on Friday evening, Dec. 14, at the Maine Christian Association house.

More than the fact that the dance was "held", is our concern that, according to the announcement, the "gay leader" (and he didn't want to be identified) said that the University Administration and the Student Senate have given official recognition to the Club and to its acceptance as part of the social life of the University. To many people this brings forth feelings of deep disgust.

Since the University receives millions of hard earned tax dollars, this new report IS of concern to many citizens represented by the Christian Civic League.



homosexuality !

It is our hope and concern that the University of Maine will
take steps to rescind any official recognition of these activities on
campus and it will no longer be subject to even the implication that
the University community approves of homosexuality.
