Background

USU'S FYE PROGRAM & LIBRARY INTEGRATION

Connections (USU 1010)

74% of students participate

3 intense days

2 credits

30 students per class

Course Objectives

- 1. Why am I here?
- 2. How do I best engage myself in the process of becoming an educated person?
- 3. How do I become a fully engaged member of the University community?

Students work in groups to solve a series of library clues



Optional

In 2019, the library workshop was no longer required



Assessment

Focus groups with Connections students in March of 2020

Assessment Findings

Lack of consistency in first-year student awareness of library resources.

Students who participated in the workshop appeared to have a more nuanced understanding of the library.

Students who did not receive the library workshop wished that there had been an **opportunity to discover the library**.

Students who attended the workshop still experienced anxiety while navigating the library building.

Many students think the library is a place of myriad opportunities, but often believe it's their responsibility to discover those opportunities.





Connections student were invited to complete a survey about the event. **149 students** completed the survey.


