What is a small business in Nebraska?

The mode number of employees that work for a business throughout the State of Nebraska is 1-4. There are more businesses in Nebraska with less than nine employees (48,331) than there are with over 10 employees (24,878).



10% of all paid workers in Nebraska are self-employed in either a non-incorporated business (6.5%) or an incorporated business (3.4%)

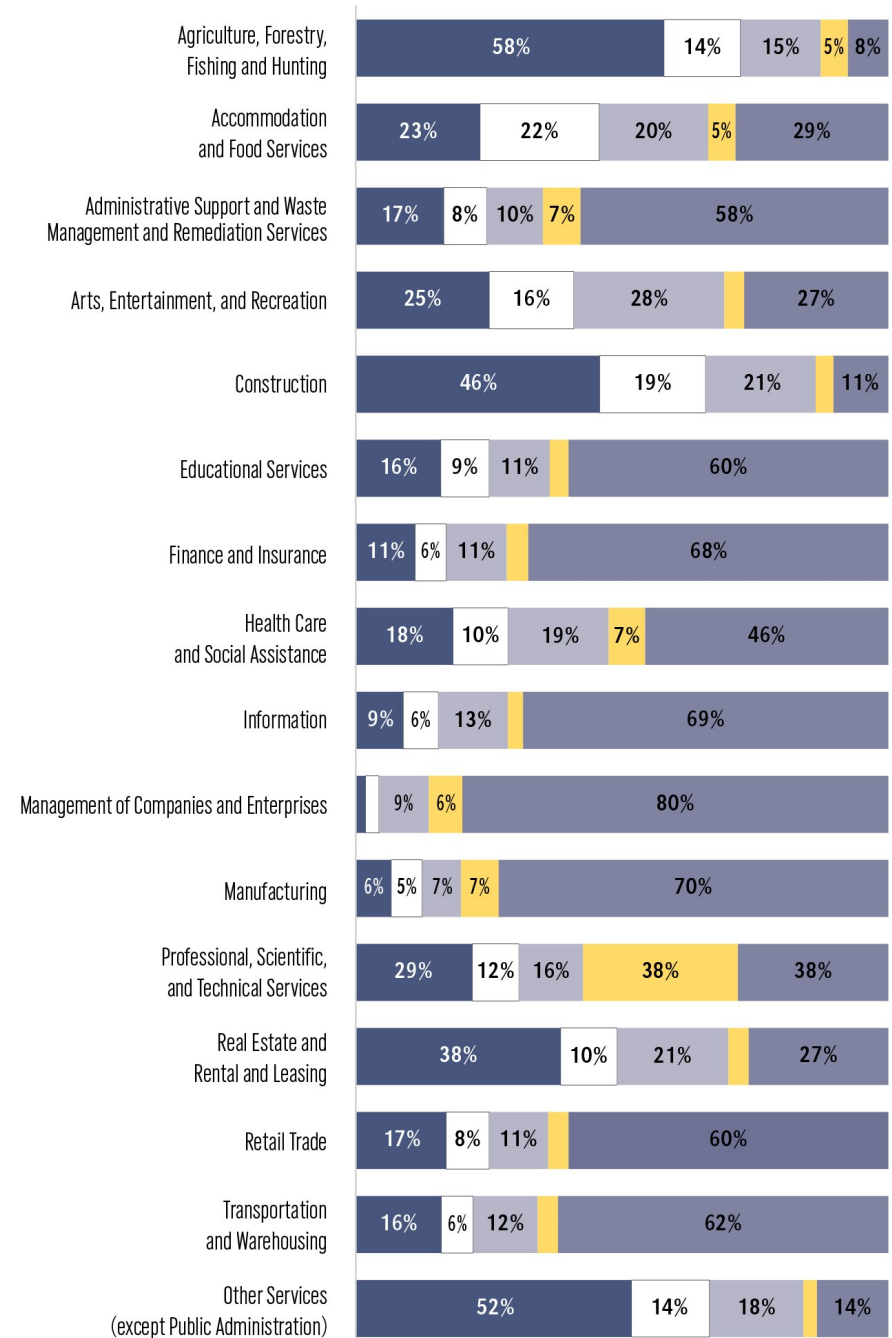
