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INTRODUCTION

Priority health risk behaviors (i.e. preventable behaviors that contribute to the leading causes of morbidity and mortality) are often established during childhood and adolescence and extend into adulthood. Ongoing surveillance of youth risk behaviors is critical for the design, implementation, and evaluation of public health interventions to improve adolescent health. The Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS) is a national surveillance system that was established in 1991 by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to monitor the prevalence of health risk behaviors among youth. YRBS data are routinely collected on high school students, but only a few states collect data in middle schools. The Nevada Middle School YRBS is biennial, anonymous and voluntary survey of students in 6th through 8th grade in regular public, charter, and alternative schools. Students self-report their behaviors in five major areas of health that directly lead to morbidity and mortality, these include:

- 1) Behaviors that contribute to unintentional injuries and violence;
- 2) Tobacco use;
- 3) Alcohol and other drug use;
- 4) Unhealthy dietary behaviors; and
- 5) Physical inactivity.

The Nevada Division of Public and Behavioral Health contracted with the University of Nevada, Reno, School of Public Health to conduct the YRBS in all middle schools throughout the state. The 2021 Nevada Middle School YRBS provides statewide data to assess priority health-risk behaviors among middle school students; measure progress toward achieving national health objectives for *Healthy People 2030* and other program and policy indicators; and evaluate the impact of school and community interventions at the national, state, and local level. It is our intention that these data will be used by education and health professionals, policy makers, community members, and researchers to improve the health of Nevada's middle school students. **This report focuses on 2021 YRBS data from Clark County Middle Schools (63 Middle Schools and 1,969 students).**

METHODS

Sampling, Weighting, and Analysis

The 2021 Nevada YRBS sampling plan was designed to ensure that every eligible student had an equal chance of selection. A random cluster sample design was used to produce a representative sample of students in grades 6-8 (all Nevada regular public, charter, and alternative middle schools). In order to provide regional data that represent all counties in the state, all 17 school districts were grouped into 8 regions that generally reflect the Nevada Statewide Coalition Partnership. The regional grouping also helped ensure that individual schools could not be identified. Next, classes were randomly selected within every school with the probability based on a required margin of error in the sample size for each region. Intact classes of either all second period or all required English courses were randomly selected from each school (second period classes were

sampled in Clark County). The questionnaire was administered to all students in sampled classes from September 2021 to December 2021. The 2021 Nevada YRBS administration was delayed from the spring semester to the fall semester due to the COVID-19 pandemic and subsequent school closures. Additionally, certain questions asking about events that occurred on school property were removed from the 2021 YRBS due to the COVID-19 pandemic-related school closures (Table 1).

The 2021 Nevada YRBS data in this report were weighted based on the sex, race/ethnicity, and grade level of students in each region. The weighting process ensured that the estimates accurately represent the entire student population in each region and the state as a whole. Non-response or poor sampling procedures can result in a sample that is not a representative subset of the population; therefore, un-weighted results from these samples may not accurately reflect student behaviors and could be misleading. This report only displays weighted results.

NOTE: Because 2021 YRBS data were collected spring semester rather than fall semester, the students were younger on average. Age can influence the risk behavior prevalence estimates. When comparing 2021 data to other years, please refer to the UNR trend reports which weight the data by age for all years compared.

Permission Status and Response Rates

The Nevada legislature passed SB69, which requires Nevada public, charter, and alternative secondary schools to participate in the Nevada YRBS. SB69 also requires passive parental permission for YRBS participation. Passive parental permission means the students take a permission form home and return it only if their parent or guardian does not want them to participate in the survey. In 2021, Clark County had an overall response rate (a combination of school and student response rates) of 69.2%.

RESULTS
