Q&A hollywood

Q: Will the series "Perception" return? It stopped in a weird place.

A: Sadly, that was it for Eric McCormack's crime-solving schizophrenic neuropsychiatrist (for those unfamiliar with the show, yes, the character was all of those things at once — crime shows don't have to be plausible).

The ratings for TNT's "Perception" were pretty varied in season 3, with the third episode drawing more viewers than the season premiere, but the most important fact from the network's perspective is that the overall trend was downward. The show took a mid-season break in August 2014, at which point it had lost more than a million viewers — almost a third of its audience — from a year earlier. So TNT pulled the plug during the break, airing the back half of season 3 in the winter of 2015.

But while the ratings were bad, they weren't terrible. It seems there were other factors at play.

In announcing the show's cancellation, TVSeriesFinale.com columnist Trevor Kimball wrote that "the cancellation is at least in part due to the cable channel's desire to move towards airing edgier series."

Indeed, "edgier" is the word that David Levy, president of TNT's parent company Turner Broadcasting, used to describe the new direction the network would be taking. "We are going to get edgier, we are going to get louder and we are going to get more dual (male-female)," he said in an interview with Deadline.com. He listed two newer shows, the spy series "Legends" and the '60s-set

cop show "Public Morals" as examples of this new direction.

"Perception's" series finale was, as you say, a little weird — there was some happily-ever-after closure for some characters, but not all. It did have a big wedding, though, which is a pretty traditional way for a show to go out.

Series star McCormack was apparently not happy with the cancellation, or at least with his career path: he switched agents this past fall.

Q: What is David James Elliott's next project? He is an excellent actor. Is there any chance he will be the next James Bond?

A: Coming off a pretty big role in the high-profile 2015 film "Trumbo," David James Elliott's next project is a modest indie picture called "Camera Store." As for his chances at one day playing James Bond, let's say they're slim.

"Camera Store" is a quiet-sounding ensemble drama set in a suburban shopping mall, and also stars fellow TV veteran John Larroquette and the great character actor John Rhys-Davies. It recently wrapped filming, but

there's no word yet on a release date (being an indie pic, a distribution deal has to be negotiated first).

Elliott, who is still best known for starring in the late-'90s/early-'00s legal drama "JAG," is coming off the role of a lifetime, playing film legend John Wayne in "Trumbo," a biography of the blacklisted screenwriter Dalton Trumbo. Elliott was nominated, along with the rest of the cast, for a Screen Actors Guild Award.

Even so, and despite fitting the profile in a number of other ways (including being an established star with a pretty distinguished look), Elliott stands little chance of taking over the Bond role from Daniel Craig. In fact, Elliott was

more or less ruled out the day he was born in Toronto, Canada.

Superspy James Bond has changed a bit over the years — Craig is a much rougher sort of spy than Roger Moore was, for example. And there have even been calls for Idris Elba, a black actor, to take on the role. However, the actors who've played Bond have always been from the British Isles. The character is a British icon — he even figured in London's Olympic opening ceremonies in 2012.

And though Canada is part of the British Commonwealth, that's likely not enough to satisfy the purists.

Ali Khan eats cheap in new Cooking Channel show

Who hasn't been there? You're in a strange city — be it on a vacation, a business trip or just a stopover — and you're hungry, but you've got a tight budget. No problem: grab a cheap bite to eat and you're good to go.

But what if you only have \$35? And what if that money has to feed you for the whole day — that's breakfast, lunch, dinner and even an afternoon snack? And what if you're a bit of a foodie who doesn't want to order off of the value menu at a chain restaurant? Impossible, right?

Wrong, apparently, and Ali Khan is out to prove it in his new Cooking Channel show, "Cheap Eats." The six-episode

Khan's not one to compromise on quality.

Khan has previously appeared on Food Network in "Grill It With Bobby Flay" and "Best Thing I Ever Made." At the young age of 26, he was made senior editor of BlackBook Magazine's Los Angeles Dining and Nightlife Guide. He's a guy who knows what to eat and where to get it, and in "Cheap Eats," he's finally sharing these tips with TV audiences.

In future episodes, Khan visits Chicago, Boulder and Albuquerque, but everywhere he goes the rules stay the same: \$35 and 12 hours to feed himself, and he has to eat well. But first, he has a rumbling stomach and a layover in Austin.

"Cheap Eats" premieres Tuesday, April 19, on Cooking Channel.

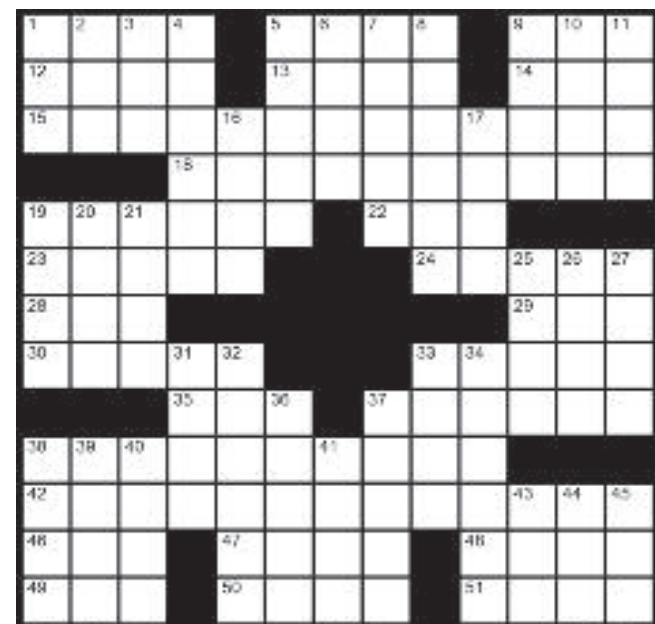

Return to form

'Grimm' a true homage to original fairy tales

Fairy tales have long been harnessed by TV networks and movie industries with great success. From Cinderella to Snow White, each story has been refashioned time and again for modern audiences. There is a reason why these fairy tales remain so popular — whether they target a young or more mature audience, they are rooted in both mystery and nostalgia.

Although newcomers to NBC's "Grimm" may think that its twist lies within the dark subject matter of the series, that darkness is actually more in line with the original stories than the majority of adaptations. Contrary to popular belief, the tales were not written by the Brothers Grimm, but collected by them from educated, middle-class women who retained them, thanks to oral tradition, and were never meant for children. They often involved topics such as murder, torture, sex and betrayal; all elements that are embodied in the fantasy crime drama. The newest episode in the series, "Good to the Bone," airs Friday, April 22, on NBC.

The show stars David Giuntoli ("13 Hours: The Secret Soldiers of Benghazi," 2016) as Nick Burkhardt, a homicide detective who, along with his partner, Hank (Russell Hornsby, "Lincoln Heights"), investigates murders connected to beings called Wesen, the real creatures that inspired the tales recorded by the Brothers Grimm. Nick has an advantage over his fellow detectives — he's a Grimm, a being who can spot Wesen and is meant to destroy them; but he's not the single-minded killer of Grimms past. In fact, his closest friend is a reformed Blutbad (German for "blood bath"), a wolf-like creature named Monroe, played by Silas Weir Mitchell ("Prison Break").

Although the series garnered mixed reviews in its first season, it has been steadily progressing in popularity as the storyline fills out. Last season, audiences were treated to an emotional ending that saw the destruction of Nick's beloved trailer, the death of Nick's mother and the apparent death of

his fiancée, Juliette (Bitsie Tulloch, "The Artist," 2011). He also formed a surprising new relationship with former Hexenbiest and nemesis Adalind (Claire Coffee, "General Hospital"). These dramatic changes left viewers with many questions about where the series might go next.

Now in its fifth season, the show is still going strong, and Nick, Hank, Monroe and the others are gearing up for their biggest fight yet.

"Watching [the show] grow has been really a pleasure," Giuntoli said in an interview with *Blasstr*. "And each season it changes. In season 5, not only is Nick at his darkest, most bloodthirsty place, but I would say there's been a reboot. We learn about whole new organizations in our government that are completely behind the scenes, covert organizations. We have new characters, new sets. ... So that's kind of been a surprise."

This season has seen the introduction of new characters and subplots, the most notable being the return of Juliette — but she's no longer the woman Nick loved: she's transformed into a mysterious Hexenbiest named Eve. Despite Eve's return, Nick and Adalind's relationship continues to grow as they are now tasked with raising their child together.

The mysteries surrounding the shady Wesen group that call themselves Black Claw, who are hellbent on bringing the world under Wesen rule, have been even more fleshed out this season as new discoveries have been made. Along with his brothers in blue — Hank, Sgt. Wu (Reggie Lee, "Prison Break") and Capt. Sean Renard (Sasha Roiz, "Warehouse 13") — Nick is forced to partner up with

familiar but shady characters in order to thwart the sinister Wesens' plans to destroy the world as they know it.

It's been a season full of twists and turns, and the exciting plotlines and beautiful cinematography are achieved, in part, by co-creators Stephen Carpenter ("The Man," 2005), David Greenwalt ("Buffy the Vampire Slayer") and Jim Kouf ("Angel"). These three are no strangers to supernatural or crime dramas. Both Greenwalt and Kouf serve as executive producers for the show, along with Sean Hayes and Todd Milliner, whose company, Hazy Mills Productions, is responsible for producing the series in conjunction with Universal Media Studios. The show is filmed in and around the Portland, Oregon, area, selected for its natural, fantastical aesthetic. Surrounded by lush forests, the area provides an incredible and whimsical setting for even the darkest of stories.

Greenwalt and Rouf do well in their modernization of the Brothers Grimm's fairy tales, infusing them with social and political commentary that make the show more relatable to its audience despite the supernatural elements. It is truly a hearkening back to the original stories; albeit, with a more puzzling and thrilling essence. The character growth alone has been a compelling enough reason to continue watching the series, but throw in a seasoned cast, reputable writers and top-notch producers, and you have a recipe for a one-of-a-kind hit show.

Let the Wesens of the world cast a spell on you in the next episode of "Grimm," airing Friday, April 22, on NBC.

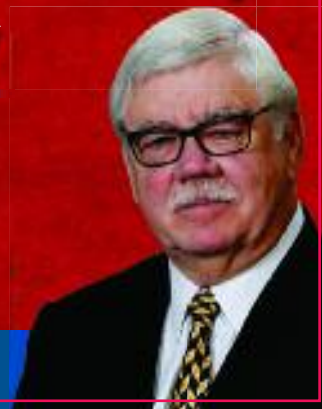

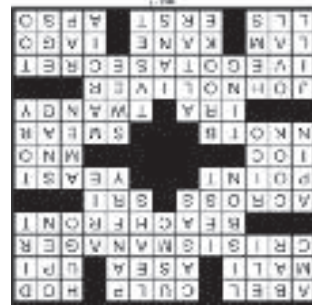
