clarify the various aspects and phases of the study; The results appear in order and the references appear appropriate. The patient group is still small, but the study looks balanced for the technical standards used. You should better specify the results during the follow-up. Minor revisions related to editorial standards such as placement of titles and other minorities. Make these corrections I consider very good the item.

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
