

CLARK UNIVERSITY

Clark University was founded in 1887 as the first all-graduate institution in America; the undergraduate college was established in 1902. During the early years of the University, graduate degrees were awarded on an individual basis. Formal commencement exercises began at Clark in June 1905, when bachelor's degrees were awarded for the first time.

The robes worn by the doctoral candidates were designed and first worn in 1991 to commemorate the one-hundredth anniversary of the awarding of the first Ph.D. at Clark. The robes are emerald green with gold University seals on the lapels. These complement the traditional doctoral hoods, reflecting the University's official colors, white and emerald.

Today's Commencement also features the flags of 59 nations and the United Nations, lining the walkway of the processional. These flags represent the homelands of all undergraduate and graduate degree recipients. With students from 92 countries in attendance at Clark and members of the faculty involved in research, training and development around the world, Clark's international character is evident and is honored today with this display.

Honors Convocation will also be broadcast outside Atwood Hall. Commencement exercises will also be televised inside Atwood Hall.

Music for this morning's program is provided by the Symphonic Brass Quartet of Worcester. Music for this afternoon's program is provided by Iain Massie, piper, and Scott Armit, drummer. A reception for graduates and guests will be held in the Kresge Quadrangle immediately following Commencement.

Academic Dress

From the cap, gown, and hood, it is possible to distinguish the institution from which the wearer was graduated, the field of learning in which his or her degree was earned, and the level of degree: bachelor's, master's, or doctor's.

The distinguishing feature of the black mortarboard cap, standard at most colleges and universities in the United States, is the color of the tassel-black for the holder of bachelor's or master's degrees, gold for doctor's degrees and the governing officers of educational institutions.

The gown is normally black, although the chief officers of many universities wear colored gowns, and several institutions have authorized optional doctoral gowns that embody the institution's colors. The level of degree is indicated by the gown's cut. The bachelor's gown, which is relatively simple, has long pointed sleeves. The master's gown is somewhat fuller, and its sleeves, which reach nearly to the wearer's knees, are squared at the ends. The gown for the doctor's degree is cut rather fully. It has velvet panels down the front and around the neck, and bell-shaped sleeves decorated with three horizontal velvet bars.

The hood is the most distinctive feature of the academic attire in the United States. Originally used as a cowl, as a shoulder cape, and as a container in which to collect alms, the hood is now worn at the back, suspended from the shoulders. The length of the hood and width of the velvet border indicate the level of the degree held. The length of the bachelor's hood is four feet long, and the border is five inches wide. The hood is lined with the official color or colors of the institution conferring the degree, and the color of the border indicates the field of learning in which the degree is earned.

# Honorary Degree Recipients

Mark Gearan has been director of the internationally respected Peace Corps since 1995, reaching out to developing countries throughout the world and promoting grassroots solutions to global problems. Founded in 1961 during the first days of the Kennedy administration, the Peace Corps has grown to 6,500 volunteers and trainees who serve in 84 countries. Under Gearan's leadership, Peace Corps volunteers are now serving for the first time in South Africa and Jordan. Gearan also launched the Crisis Corps, a new program within the organization that allows volunteers to provide shortterm assistance to international communities during crises and natural disasters. Prior to taking charge of the Peace Corps, Gearan served as assistant to the President and White House director of communications, as well as White House deputy chief of staff. A native of Gardner, Mass., Gearan earned his undergraduate degree from Harvard College and a J.D. from Georgetown University Law Center. He will receive the doctor of humane letters degree.

Acclaimed high-energy physicist **Leon Lederman** won the Nobel Prize in 1988 for discovering the muon-neutrino, a new class of sub-nuclear particles. During his lifetime of research, Lederman's pioneering work has led to major break-throughs in the understanding of particle physics, contributing to what is now accepted as the "standard model" in the field. Lederman is director emeritus of the Fermi National Accelerator Laboratory in Batavia, Ill., and holds an appointment as the Pritzker Professor of Science at the Illinois Institute of Technology in Chicago. For more than 30 years, Lederman has been associated with Columbia University in New York City, where he was a student and faculty member. In 1995, Lederman was awarded the Enrico Fermi Prize by President Clinton for his contributions to scientific research and service to the scientific community. He will receive the doctor of science degree.

**Ogretta McNeil** is distinguished for her many significant contributions to the Worcester community. After receiving a bachelor's degree from Howard University in 1954, McNeil earned both a master of arts and a Ph.D. in psychology from Clark University. During her 27-year tenure as a professor of psychology and administrator at the College of the Holy Cross in Worcester, McNeil developed outreach and education programs that helped countless individuals, from special advising for students of color to assistance for the aged. She was recently elected to the Worcester School Committee and serves on the boards of several community organizations, including the Alliance for Education, the New England Science Center and the Worcester Age Center. She will receive a doctor of civic leadership degree.

William McNeill is noted for work that crosses boundaries—his books have connected history to economics, epidemiology and even dance. During his 40-year tenure at the University of Chicago, where McNeill earned his doctorate, he wrote the classic *Rise of the West* and numerous other influential books and scholarly articles. McNeill has held visiting appointments in higher education institutions throughout Europe, including those in Germany and England. In 1996, he was awarded the Erasmus Prize by the Dutch government—the first such honor ever given to an American—for his contributions to European culture, society and social science. He will receive the doctor of humane letters degree.

Clark alumnus and research psychologist **Irving Sigel** is renowned for his work on intellectual development in children. Sigel was raised in Worcester and graduated from Clark University in 1943 with a degree in psychology. He then earned M.A. and Ph.D. degrees from the University of Chicago and focused his research on the role of family in a child's intellectual development. Sigel found that parental language and dialogue play a vital role in the early development of intellectual competence. He is a distinguished research psychologist (emeritus) for the Educational Testing Service, which administers well-known assessment tests for entrance into colleges and graduate schools. He will receive the doctor of science degree.
