COMMENTS FOR THE AUTHOR:

Reviewer #1: The revision has addressed all issues pointed out in the previous round review. The reviewer is happy about the revision and recommends the paper for publication.

Reviewer #3: It is interesting to see some statistical analysis of the impact of temporal features on tweet clustering as well as the details of matrix updating rules in this revision. However, the added content is just a more detailed explanation of the approaches proposed in a previously published paper (WISE 2015), making the contribution of this paper very limited. What can be really regarded as an acceptable extension is the improvement of technical depth, namely what are the new challenges identified in this paper and what are the new approaches to solve them? In fact, handling dynamic tweet stream in an incremental manner would be a perfect option for extension, but the authors have not addressed it. Therefore, I would expect more innovative techniques in the next revision, namely those methods proposed after WISE 2015.
