I take this opportunity to inform you that I am well, and doing well Mother and all of the family is well, the Cholera has come up last this ~~few~~ <sup>few</sup> days & Cases all of which I will expect it is reported in the Country that it is very bad but that is not true! I do not <sup>w</sup>hole alarmed at all for I think if a <sup>person</sup> takes care of themselves there is no danger or <sup>Afraid</sup> town? you must not be afraid to come to town on account of the Cholera for I do not think that there is any danger when you come to town you must come and see us. I must stop writing for it is dinner time.
