I Take this opportunity to inform you that I am Well, and Doing Well Mother and all of the Family is Well, the Cholera has come at last this House & Cures all of which I will expect it is Reported in the Country that it is very Bad But that is not True! I do not feel alarmed at all for I think if a Person ^{PERSON?} takes ^{CARE} Care of themselves there is no danger I am staying ~~at~~ ^{TOWN?} Mrs Manns Store on High St you must not be afraid ^{AFRAID?} to come to Town on account of the Cholera for I do not think that there is any danger when you come to Town you must come and see us. I must stop writing for it is summer time.
