Do You Know about Pivot-RP?

Searching for an external funding opportunity such as a grant, fellowship, or other award? Have you looking for an opportunity that aligns with your research, teaching, education, or service goals? For Ole Miss employees and students, UM's Pivot-RP subscription can make this process easier and more fruitful. Pivot-RP is a comprehensive, searchable database of funding opportunities and U.S. scholar profiles that covers all academic and discipline areas.

Login to Pivot using your University of Mississippi credentials (Webld and password). If this is your first time to access Pivot-RP, you will first need to create an account, after which you will be prompted to claim (and update) your Scholar Profile. You will note that a draft profile has already created for you based on information found on the Internet. If you are a student or don't yet have a pre-fabricated Scholar Profile, you can create one (or just skip this step to get started searching for opportunities).

Access Pivot-RP

There's a lot that Pivot RP can do for you, but it may require some customization and finesse. To get the most out of Pivot-RP, build custom searches and narrow the search attributes such as funder type, award type, applicant type, etc. Make

cure your profile is up to date. The link to the Divet DD VouTube channel will
