Dear Madam:

We received your letter of February 9th, and in reply would say that it is absolutely impossible to arrange a loan for you unless you are in New York to sign the necessary authorization papers.

The loan, if it is negotiated would be for \$10,000. with payments of about \$250.00 quarterly. This would reduce your payments from what they are at present by \$500.00 per year, as up to this time you have been paying \$1000.00 a year on the third mortgage, and \$500.00 a year on the second mortgage, whereas, according to the new arrangements if the mortgage can be placed you will only be paying \$1000.00 per year.
