Warrant For Town Meeting

To MAYNARD ALBEE, a Constable of the Town of Alna in the County of Lincoln, Greeting:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Alna, qualified by law to vote on town affairs to meet at the Old Meeting House in said town on the fifth day of March, A. D., 1945 at one o'clock in the afternoon, then and there to act on the following articles, to wit:

- ART. 1 To choose a Moderator.
- ART. 2 To choose a Clerk for the ensuing year.
- ART. 3 To act on report of Town Officers.
- ART. 4 To choose Selectmen.
- ART. 5 To choose Assessors.
- ART. 6 To choose Overseers of Poor.
- ART. 7 To choose a Treasurer.
- ART. 8 To choose a Collector of Taxes.
- ART. 9 To choose one member Board of Trustees of Alna Cemetery for three years.
- ART. 10 To choose one member of School Committee for three years.
 - ART, 11 To choose one or more Fire Wardens.

- ART. 12 To see if the Town will choose one or more Road Commissioners to handle common roads or leave it with the Selectmen.
- ART. 13 To choose all other necessary Town Officers.
- ART. 14 To see what method the Town will adopt for collection of Taxes and fix compensation for same.
- ART. 15 To see if the Town will vote to raise \$300.00 for Maintenance of Third Class Road.
- ART. 16 To see what sum the Town will vote to raise for Cutting and Burning Bushes on improved roads.
- ART. 17 To see if the Town will vote to raise \$463.20 for Patrol Maintenance.
- ART. 18 To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for Incidental Expenses.
- ART. 19 To see if the Town will vote to clear snow on all roads in cooperation with State.
- ART. 20 To see what sum of money the Town will vote to raise for Snow bills.
- ART. 21 To raise money for the following purposes: Schools, Poor, Town Officers, Ways and Bridges, School Buildings, School Books, Tuition.
- ART. 22 To see what sum the Town will vote to raise to maintain the electric lights now in use.
- ART. 23 To see if the Town will raise and appropriate \$35.00 for Public Health Nursing.

- ART. 24 To see if the Town will raise and appropriate \$40.00 for Dental Hygiene work.
- ART. 25 To see what sum the Town will vote to raise for Abatements.
- ART. 26 To see if the Town will vote to raise \$15.00 for Memorial purposes for the Bradford-Sortwell-Wright Post, American Legion, Wiscasset.
- ART. 27 To authorize the Selectmen to borrow sums of money in anticipation of taxes.
- ART. 28 To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen on behalf of the Town to sell and dispose of any real estate acquired by the Town for non-payment of taxes thereon; on such terms as they deem advisable, and to execute quitclaim deeds for such property.
- ART. 29 (a) To see if the Town will vote to build a Consolidated School Building. (b) To see what action the Town will take as to location, and purchasing a site for a Consolidated School Building and playground. (c)To see if the Town will vote to raise \$1000.000 to start a Consolidated School Fund.
- ART. 30 To see if the Town will vote to raise \$250.00 to shingle one side of roof of Old Meeting House and repair foundation of same.
- ART. 31 To see if the Town will vote to discontinue the old road, from what is known as Lothrop's Corner to the old Bog School Corner.
- ART. 32 To see if the Town will vote to discontinue the old road from opposite Scott Rankin's house to the Whitefield line.

ART. 33 To transact any other business that may legally come before said meeting.
