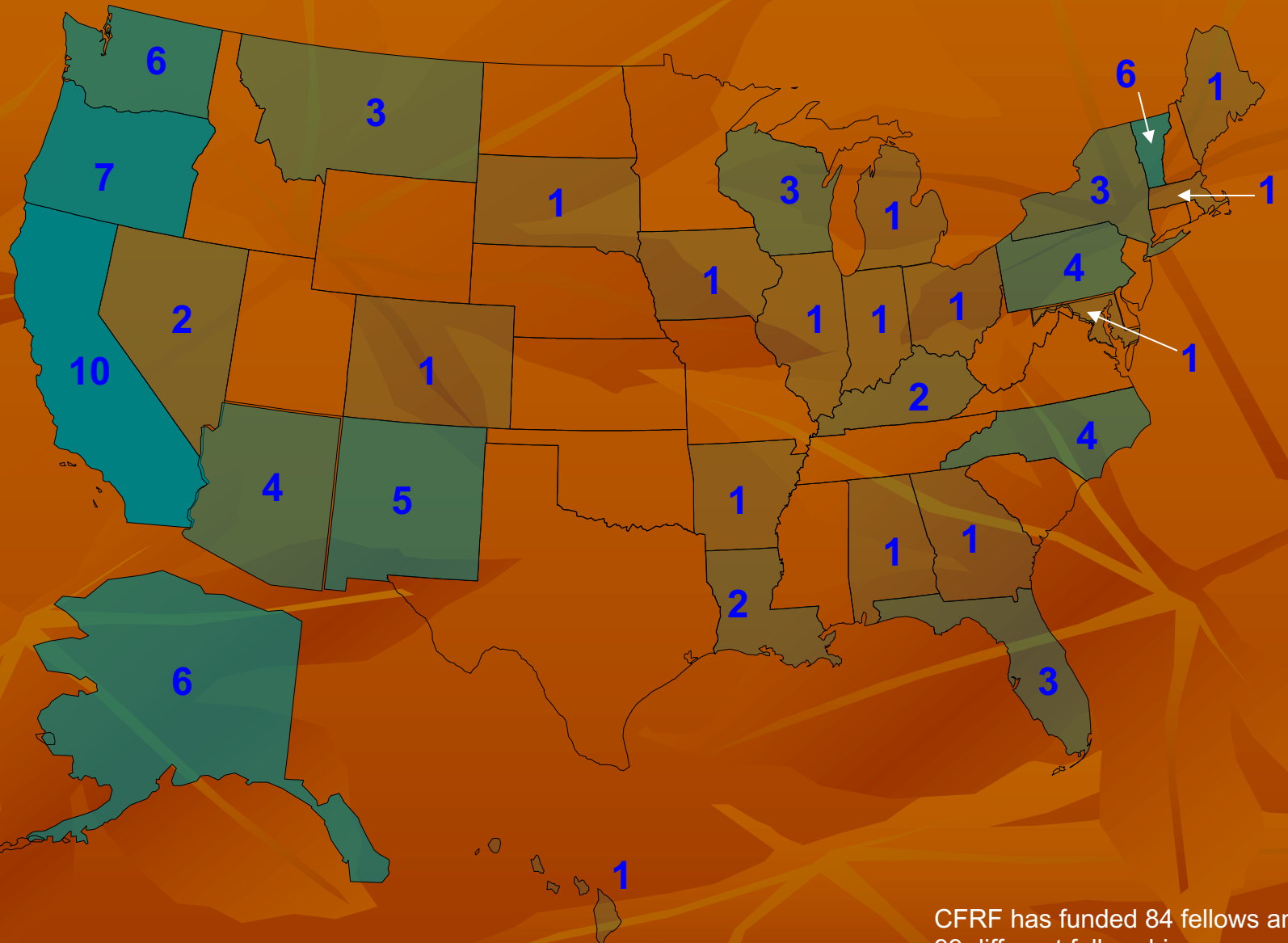
- Fund graduate students

CFRF Graduate Research Sites by State 1997 – 2007

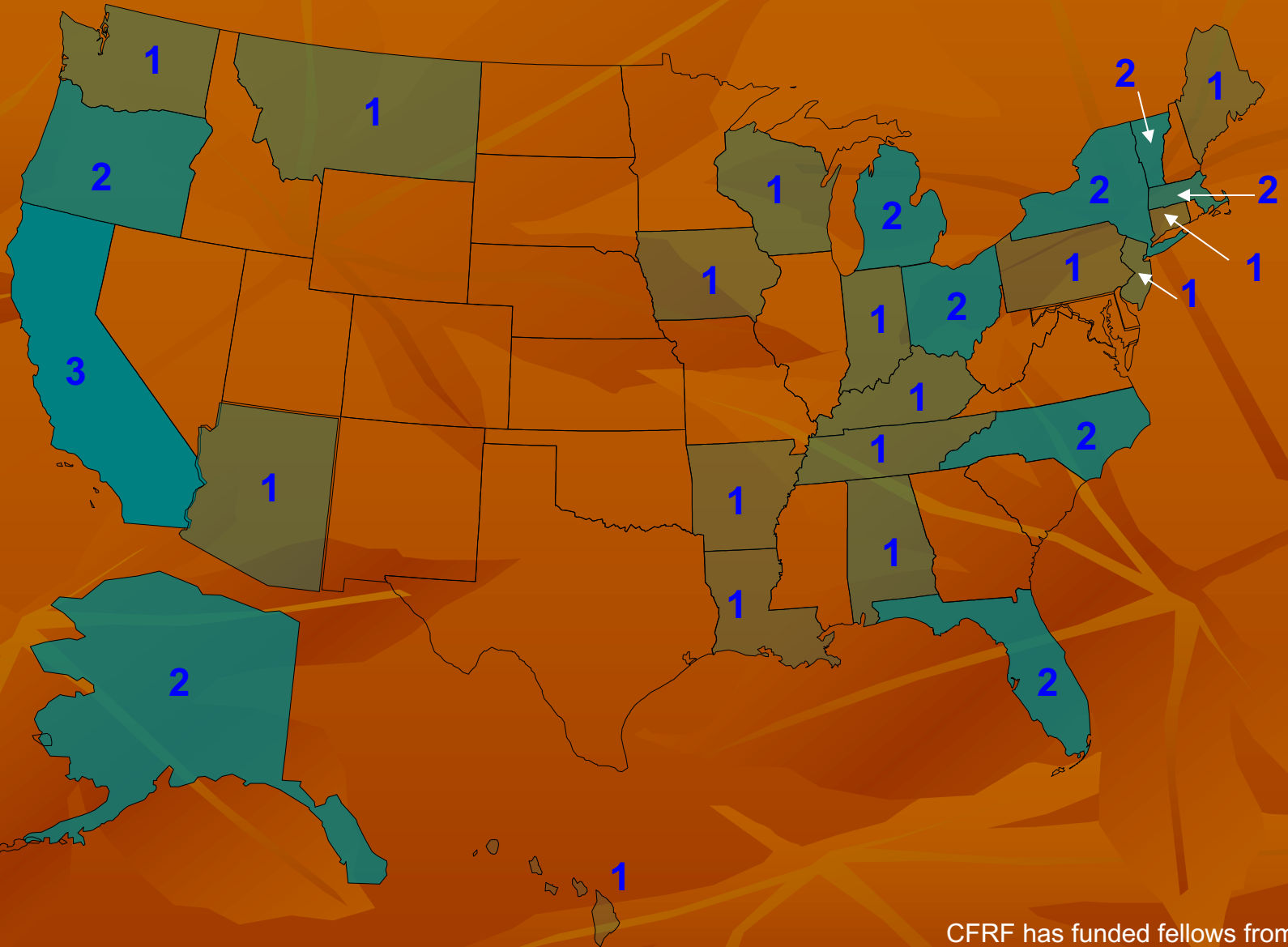
Masters, Pre-dissertation & Dissertation Fellowships

Number of universities per state attended by CFRF fellows



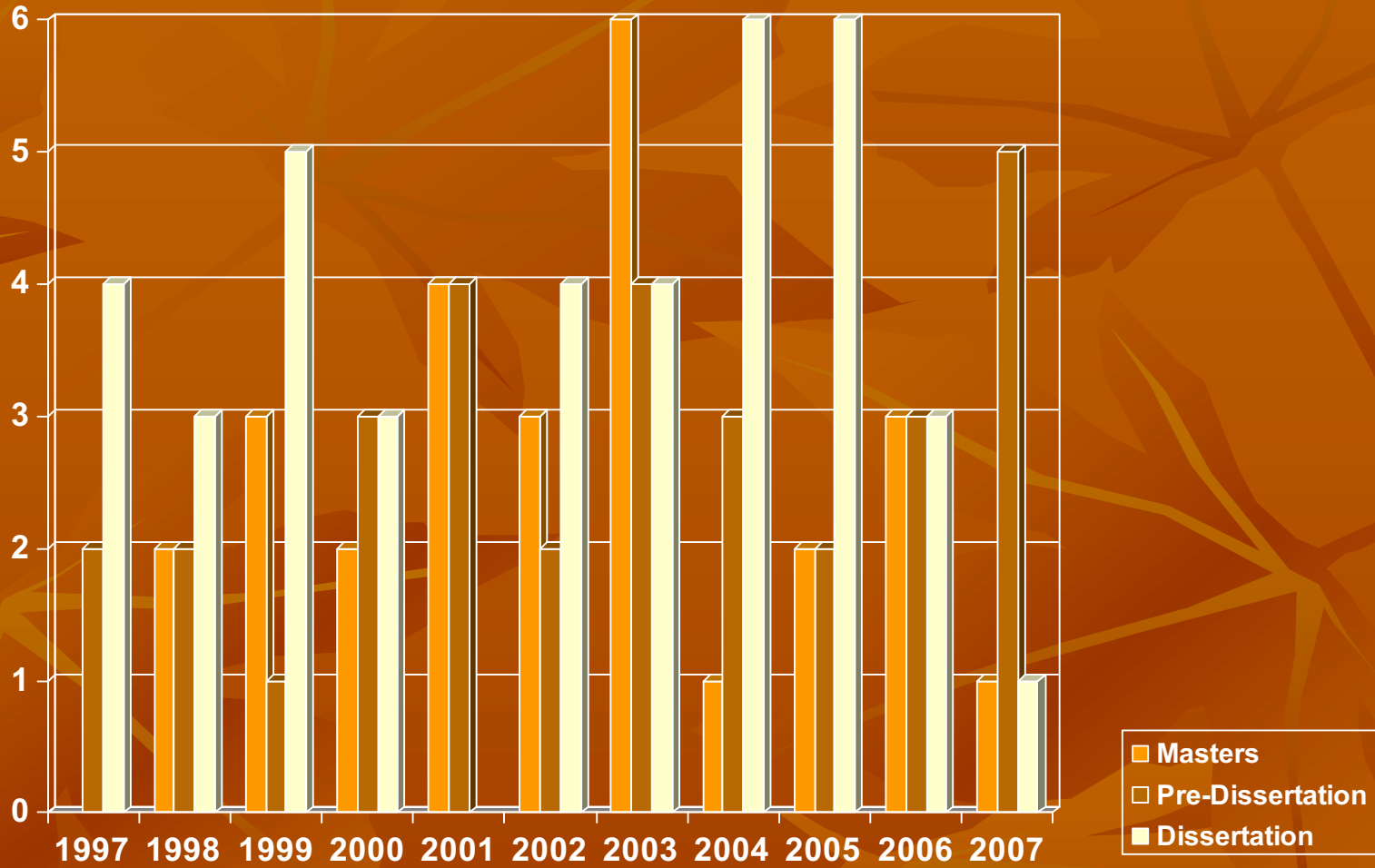
CFRF has funded fellows from 36 different U.S. universities.
