I enjoyed reading your October 22, 1992 address "Preserving the Past" to the Association of the Bar of the City of New York. Bill Josephson of Fried, Frank, Harris, Shriver and Jacobson shared this with me.

You might like to have a copy of Duely and Constantly Kept (enclosed), a history of the New York Supreme Court of Judicature and a guide to our holdings of the records of this court. We published this jointly with the New York Court of Appeals in 1991. I've also attached several issues of our newsletter, *For The Record*, and a description of the new State Archives Partnership Trust. A substantial portion of the proceeds of the Trust endowment will support work to preserve and make accessible our holdings of colonial and pre-1847 court records, and to draw on them for public and educational programs.
