But as we strive for the future,

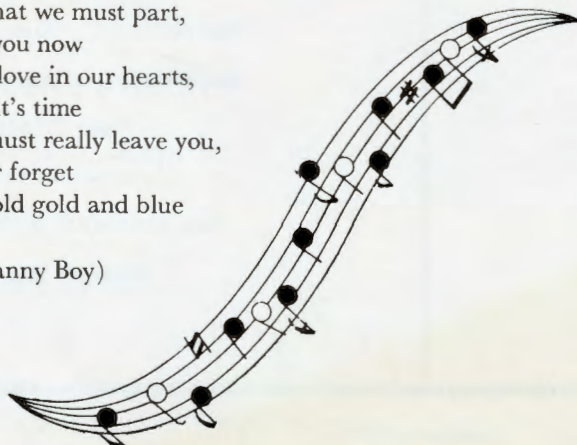

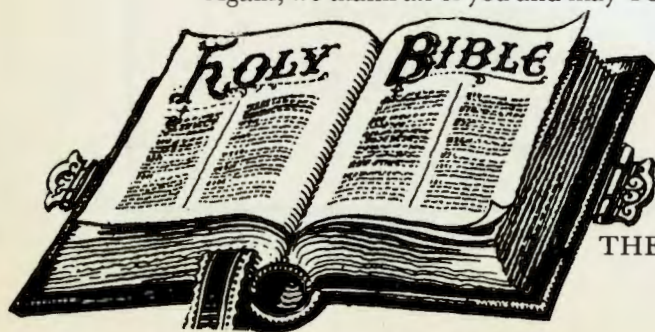
