BIOGRAPHIES

JEFF COFFIN

Jeff Coffin is a globally celebrated saxophonist, composer, and educator, and is recognized for his breathtakingly singable and enigmatic compositions, his searing improvisations, and his very unusual facial hair. He is a member of the legendary U.S. rock group, Dave Matthews Band, and you may also know him from his fourteen-year tenure, and three Grammy Awards, with the genredefying Bela Fleck & the Flecktones.

Jeff Coffin's 2022 Grammy-nominated release, *Between Dreaming and Joy*, is a stunning display of Coffin's boundless compositional impulse and eclectic sonic arrest and was released on his own Ear Up Records. With over twenty solo releases (and 45+ overall) on Ear Up, Coffin is proud to celebrate, but not get stuck in, his independent label's first Grammy-nominated recording—an impressive feat for the seasoned woodwind player! Jeff is also a Yamaha Performing Artist & Clinician, a Boston Sax Shop Ambassador, and a JodyJazz Artist. He teaches improvisation at the prestigious Vanderbilt University, has written numerous music books, authored a children's book, produces, engineers, mixes, draws, and continues to be recognized for his musical passion, his deep commitment to music education, and his tireless dedication to improvisational music.

NIR FELDER

Called "the next big jazz guitarist" by NPR and hailed by the *New York Times* as a "whiz kid," Nir Felder is a new voice in jazz guitar. He spent his youth playing in rock bands while learning about jazz at the local record store, inspired by icons from John Coltrane to Jimi Hendrix. In 2006, he moved to New York City and quickly became one of the city's most highly sought-after sidemen, performing and recording with an eclectic group of luminaries in jazz and other genres including Diana Krall, Erykah Badu, Brad Mehldau, John Mayer, and Ben Platt (for the Netflix special *Live at Radio City Music Hall*), among many others. He has toured throughout six continents and at venues including Radio City Music Hall and the Village Vanguard, and appeared on national television stations NBC, ABC, CBS, ESPN, and Fox in a variety of shows including *Good Morning America*, the *Late Show with Stephen Colbert*, the *Ellen DeGeneres Show, Jimmy Kimmel Live!*, and the U.S. Open, among others.

Seeking a more personal creative outlet, Felder first formed his own quartet in 2010, recording the critically acclaimed debut *Golden Age* (Sony/OKeh), called "lyrical and lofty" by the *New York Times*, "mesmerizing" by the *Boston Globe*, and "mindboggling" by *All About Jazz*. Six years after the release of *Golden Age*, Felder's latest project is a set of two trio recordings featuring bassist Matt Penman and drummer Jimmy Macbride. Using the studio as an instrument and the latest in sound design technology, the result is layered music that blends jazz improvisation with other genres in new ways and stretches the boundaries of what a jazz record is and can be. Felder is the 2021 winner of the *DownBeat* Critics Poll in the Rising Star Guitarist category. He is on faculty at Boston's Berklee College of Music and The New School in New York City.

FELIX PASTORIUS

The son of Jaco Pastorius, Felix Pastorius has worked hard and achieved his own voice on the electric bass. He continues to write and release his own music theory books. He is the bassist for his bands Hipster Assassins and Social Experiment, tours with Cindy Blackman Santana and Jeff Coffin's Mu'tet, and has worked with the Yellowjackets, A\$AP Rocky, and Onyx Collective, among others.

CHRIS WALTERS

Born in New Orleans, Chris moved from New York to Nashville in 1989. When not touring with his own band, Chris performs and records as the keyboardist with various artists, including The Jeff Coffin Mu'tet, JD Souther, and The Peter Mayer Group. He has performed with the Nashville Symphony Orchestra and recorded the soundtrack for a documentary film scored by Bela Fleck.

At the age of 18, Walters was a finalist in the Chattanooga Symphony Orchestra's Gershwin competition. Chris attended the jazz studies program at Webster University in St. Louis and was listed by them as a notable alumnus in a recent *Downbeat* magazine article. His debut album, *Strange Fruit*, was featured on National Public Radio's *Jazz South* program, and his 2003 release, *Cool Blue Swing*, garnered praise for eleven tracks of original music.

His most recent CD, Yay! Everybody, Yay!, features new original songs as well as works by Alberto Ginastera and Cole Porter, with orchestrations around his small group performances.

JORDAN PERLSON

The career of drummer, percussionist, producer, and educator, Jordan Perlson has spanned about as wide a stylistic reach as one can imagine. Be it with jazz legends Seamus Blake, Gary Burton, and David Liebman, or folk heroes Alison Brown and Missy Raines, or reggae giants Matisyahu and Trevor Hall, cuttingedge music innovators like Becca Stevens, Snarky Puppy, Banda Magda, and Jeff Coffin, progressive music with Adrian Belew, Echolyn or Kaki King, or fusion megastar Hiromi, Jordan has become a known force in these many circles. Credits on 100+ recordings, including national and international ad campaigns for Powerade, Netflix, The NY Rangers, Buick, and more, Jordan is at home in the studio as he is on stage.
