Revision notes:

The materials in the Bangs Collection were left in original order according to a letter dated Nov. 9, 1984, from archivist Randy J. Sparks to Dr. Tina E. Bangs, but were moved from two large Hollinger boxes and placed into 6 smaller boxes which occupy 2-1/2 linear feet.

Staples were removed. When necessary to help retain original order, the materials were interleaved with archival bond or put into L-velopes. Correspondence and reports on acidic paper were copied onto archival bond and discarded. Legal documents folded and housed in letter-sized folders were unfolded and the letter-sized folders replaced with identically numbered legal folders.
