Producing a group handbook to improve research culture and inclusivity – our experiences






Background

We were awarded funds to create a **handbook** for the **Animal Welfare and Behaviour (AWB) group** at Bristol Veterinary School. This work was financed by the Enhancing Research Culture Fund distributed by the University of Bristol, and supplied by Research England.

Between **January and July 2023** we collectively discussed, developed, drafted, and delivered our 66-page handbook.
