



WHAT DO WE CALL OPEN ACCESS?

- Open Access (OA) refers to freely accessible, online, digital information (openscience.hu).
- It is a global initiative aimed at eliminating knowledge acquisition disparities arising from a lack of financial resources and intellectual property restrictions.
- Open access documents, in accordance with the applicable licenses, can be downloaded, shared, reused, and adapted.
- Bringing closer science to civil society is facilitated by providing research materials not only to insiders but to a wider audience. The concept generally refers to two areas:
 - peer-reviewed scientific articles and journals,
 - and research data.

The options for authors are usually marked with colors.

GOLD OPEN ACCESS

- The essence is that the publisher's version can be shared right after publication. The publisher may request an Article Processing Charge (APC).
- Diamond journals, e.g., ELTE OJS (Open Journal Systems).
- APC supports:
 - EISZ Read and Publish agreements
 - Faculty support systems
 - MDPI
