Lea Durante

Lea Durante teaches History of Criticism and of Literary Historiography at the University of Bari in the “heel” of Italy. She is vice-president of the Italian section of International Gramsci Society and a member of the IGS’s secretariat at world level. As well as her Gramsci work, she has written on the twentieth-century novel and literary theory and criticism

Joseph Francese

Joseph Francese is University Outstanding Faculty at the University of Michigan (USA), where he is full professor of Italian Literature. He has published numerous articles and chapters on modern and contemporary Italian writers and intellectuals, and in 2009 edited the Routledge volume *Perspectives on Gramsci: Culture, Politics, and Social Theory*. He is the long-time Senior Editor of the US-based journal *Italian Culture*.

Fabio Frosini

Fabio Frosini teaches History of Philosophy and History of Political Theory at the University of Urbino in central Italy. Apart from figures in these fields, his work on Gramsci is wide-ranging, covering many key concepts encountered in the prison writings in particular, and also encompasses a role on the *National Edition of Gramsci’s Writings*. His contributions include, in Italy, various publications in the International Gramsci Society series of volumes.

Nerio Naldi

Nerio Naldi is Associate Professor of Political Economy at the Sapienza-Università di Roma. He has made a special study of the theory of value in Adam Smith and his forerunners and of investment analysis in Keynes. He has worked on Gramsci and on the close personal and intellectual relationship between him and Piero Sraffa. He has researched the work and biography of the latter, collaborates with the *Centro Piero Sraffa* and is on the advisory board of the *Centro Sraffa Working Papers*.
