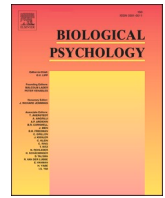

The authors regret “that after publication of the manuscript, they realized that the variable ‘body mass index’ (BMI) was not calculated correctly due to an error in data transmission. The correct mean values (standard deviation) for BMI in Table 1 should be 25.63 (3.09) kg/m<sup>2</sup> for

the burnout group and 24.35 (2.72) kg/m<sup>2</sup> for the control group. The P-value for the group comparison should be .094. The authors state that this error in no way alters the scientific conclusions of the article.”
