



In this latter connexion, I am also sending to you herewith a list of interpreters, indicating the monies disbursed, that have been hired thus far for the investigation as well as the names of those on the reserve list that may start working on short notice, if required. You will also note that we are in the process of hiring two clerk/typists to assist the lawyers to type their testimonies, in addition to our full-time administrative assistant, Ms. Masa Mlakar.

I would greatly appreciate your prompt advice as to the 4. per diem for food and lodgings that the interpreters are to receive in view of the cost of the lodgings at some locations. It should be noted that the transportation cost for each interpreter that has travelled out of Zagreb must be reimbursed.


<u>N.B.:</u>

a) All interpreters deployed to areas outside of Zagreb have been given USD \$ 50 to cover local expenses, such as hotel and meals; a sort of per diem.

b) We are in the process of recruiting, as of 8 March 1994, at least one, possibly two, clerk-typist at USD \$ 30/day (the UNPROFOR rate being between USD \$ 28 to \$ 33).

c) The Core Group prepared a confidentiality undertaking also herewith that was signed by each interpreter. UNPROFOR is in the process of preparing individual contracts for them.
