Belgrade Mission I | spoke today to | Civil Affairs, UNPROFOR, | Belgrade, concerning the Belgrade visit. I was informed that I will receive an official reply soon on the planned visit from the Belgrade authorities. Other Business As Ms. Greve will remain in Zagreb until 15 February, I told Mr. Kotliar today that I too should remain here until that date. However, Mr. Kotliar prefers that I leave Zagreb on 13 February so that I could start preparing, on 14 February, for the Eleventh Session of the Commission. Personnally, I believe that I should remain in Zagreb until 15 February. Best regards.
