NYMC Faculty Mentor Two Semi-Finalists in Regeneron Science Talent Search Contest

Three hundred semi-finalists were selected from 2,162 entrants from 712 high schools across 46 states, Puerto Rico and ten other countries in the 2024 Regeneron Science Talent Search. The select included two students mentored by NYMC faculty. Justin Baldasarre from Hastings High School, mentored by Dazhong Xu, Ph.D., associate professor of pathology, microbiology and

immunology, presented his research, "STING-Rich Ciliated Cells Protect the Fallopian Tube from Early Transformation in the Development of Ovarian Cancer;" and Anwen Cao from Horace Greeley High School, mentored by Christopher Whitehurst, Ph.D., assistant professor of pathology, microbiology, and immunology, and of biochemistry and molecular biology, presented "An Exploration of mTOR in Epstein-Barr Virus: Evaluating the Effect of EBV Deubiquitinating Enzyme BPLF1 on mTOR Complex 1 and 2." In recognition of their accomplishments, both students and their schools will be awarded \$2,000 each for their outstanding work.
