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## SustainaWHAT?! 2023 Aims and Events

#### To provide PGRs (and PGT/ECRs) the opportunity :

1. to bring a **sustainability** lens (via UNSDGs) to their prospective research with a view to informing the rationale and **potential impact** of their research

2. to **develop** a range of competencies applicable to their own research and personal/ professional contexts, including **interdisciplinary collaboration** 

3. to **develop a network** of PGRs, PGTs and ECRs interested and involved in **sustainability** within and across the **three institutions** 

#### Aims for the PGR organising team:

4. To offer PGRs knowledge and skills development in **sustainability and event** organisation and facilitation (see <u>blog post</u>)


5. To develop skills and competencies to **collaborative effectively** across teams and organisations




## Legacy from SustainaWHAT?!



 With two successful events behind us, we are now exploring how the concept can be expanded, through the establishment of our PGR network: 'SPROUT - PGR Sustainability Collective', alongside SustainaWHAT?!

This will be run by PGRs for PGRs





- A **PGR led network** to connect PGRs across UK HE, starting at Bournemouth University, Cardiff University and the University of Newcastle.
- Our mission is to connect and nurture PGRs, aspiring PGRs and ECRs who are interested in developing our understanding about how sustainability can enhance the rationale for and impact of their research now and in the future.





# **SPROUT's mission**

- 1. To build **confidence** amongst PGRs, aspiring PGRs and ECRs in **engaging with sustainability**.
- 2. To provide opportunities within a **community of practice** to develop peers' understanding about sustainability.
- 3. To increase awareness of sustainability's role in **employability and funding** opportunities.
- 4. To provide **collaborative opportunities** for PGRs and ECRs to develop a **range of competencies** applicable to their own research and personal/ professional contexts.







#### **Summary**

- SustainaWHAT?! is a set of collaborative, multi- and inter-disciplinary events which draw on expertise from students, staff and external contributors
- Co-creation with PGR leads working with academics
- We feel that we have established the importance of sustainability in enhancing PGR research
- Adding SPROUT to the portfolio to further build and support a community of PGRs (+ECRs/PGTs/supporting academics)
