



- **Abstract:**
Helicobacter pylori infects more than half the human population. However, the prevalence of infection in Indonesia, the fourth most populous country, is low. Ethnicity is an important determinant of the infection rate in Indonesia. The infection rate is higher in Batakese, Papuans and Buginese than in Javanese, the predominant ethnic group. Ethnicity is also an important determinant of the genetic characteristics of *H. pylori*. Analysis of CagA in the EPIYA segment showed that the predominant genotypes in Papuans, Batakese and Buginese are ABB-, ABD- and ABC-type CagA, respectively. An antibiotic susceptibility survey showed that the standard triple therapy for *H. pylori* infection can still be used with caution in several cities. There is a very high rate of resistance to second-line regimens such as levofloxacin and metronidazole. Recent studies have shown that furazolidone, rifabutin and sitafloxacin are potential alternative treatments for antibiotic-resistant *H. pylori*.
