What is mentorship?

- The *goal* of mentorship is to foster personal and professional development.
- The *activities* of mentorship are about sharing:
 - Knowledge
 - Skills
 - Experience
 - Specific scenarios
- The outcomes of mentorship are:
 - Growth
 - Increased confidence
 - Success



What is the structure of mentorship?

- The structure of mentorship typically implies a hierarchy
 - Mentor
 - Mentee
- Mentorship can be more collaborative
 - Mentor circles
- RAMP structure will be shaped by the skills and interests of participants



Why we created RAMP

- Research Analytics
 - Requires practice
 - Is best understood in specific scenarios
 - Is an emergent area of expertise
- Learning and growth through mentorship is an ideal structure for developing capacity, confidence, and success in research analytics.

- Research administrators from higher education institutions who have:
 - Access to relevant institutional data
 - Institutional support
- Preference for attendees at this conference
